# CNRS: A LEADING EUROPEAN RESEARCH PERFORMING INSTITUTION

- A **32,000-strong workforce**, incl. 24,600 permanent staff
  - 11 200 researchers
  - 13 400 engineers, technicians and administrative staff
- **2017 budget : 3,5 b€** (2,7 b€ State subsidy + 780 k€ self-generated income)
- Over 1 000 research units and 100 service units
  - 95% of research carried out in partnership with universities, national, European and international Institutes, and private companies, within joint research units (UMR)
- More than 50 000 publications/year (Scopus), incl. 60% co-signed with a foreign laboratory



# **CNRS IN RANKINGS**

- 1<sup>st</sup> hosting institution of ERC Advanced Grants in 2019 (15)
  1<sup>st</sup> hosting inst. of ERC Grants from 2007 when the program was launched (536, incl 21 in 2018)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> in the world 2018 Nature Index Article count ranking
- 8<sup>th</sup> world most innovative public research institution Source : 2017 Reuters' Top 25 Global Innovative Institutions
- 22 Nobel Prize laureates, 12 Fields Medal award winners and 1 Turing Award recipient





European Research and Technology Development with Japan

- Initiated by EU and JST, now multinational joint funding research program ۲
- **On-going call on SMART WATER MANAGEMENT FOR SUSTAINABLE SOCIETY**
- Deadline: 14 June 2019
- Selected projects will be funded for a 3-year period. The projects are expected to have mobility and ۰ networking dimension, in addition to the core research component. Each applying consortium should consist of at least 3 partners, including one from Japan and two from two different European countries.
